# The Golf Courses

# Ridgecrest GC



3730 Ridgecrest Drive, Nampa, Idaho 83687 (208) 468-9073 Ridgecreat is a championship course designed by John Harbottle and opened in 1996. There are 7 water holes, 4 waste bunkers and 30 bunkers to avoid. The layout was built on rolling corn fields. Look out for hole #12. This hole drops off the 200 foot ridge of Ridgecrest to a green surrounded in the front by bunkers, and on the right by water. Also be careful of #17. This hole requires a long drive down the center of the fairway, because you need a lofted iron to get up the large hill where the narrow green rests. The green is very narrow and is has two bunkers guarding the front and back. Birdies are few and far between.

# **Shadow Valley GC**

15711 Highway 55, Boise, ID 83714 (208) 939-6699 Shadow Valley is the unique and challenging golf course you've been looking for. Nestled in the foothills, north of Boise, Idaho, Shadow Valley Golf Course has earned a reputation for eye-catching golf because of its picturesque setting. Built a quarter century ago along the Boise front, the front nine alone features a dozen elevation changes, including the new No. 6 hole, a challenging par-3 cut from the side of the foothills. The aesthetics are unmatched with its rock formations, blooming flower beds, ponds and waterfall.



# **Banbury GC**



2626 South Marypost Place, Eagle, Idaho 83616 (208) 939-3600 Designed by John Harbottle III, BanBury Golf Course meanders around the South Channel of the Boise River, successfully uniting golf with native habitat. A challenging 6,890 yard par 71 public course, BanBury Golf Course has been consistently rated in the top ten golf courses in Idaho by Golf Digest in the past seven years. Banbury GC is host Site for the 2009 Rocky Mountain PGA Idaho Open and was host Site for the 2008 PNGA Men's Amateur Championship

#### **Falcon Crest GC**

11102 S. Cloverdale Road, Kuna, Idaho 83634 (208) 362-8897 Falcon Crest offers a challenge to golfers of all skill levels. A golf oasis, Falcon Crest blends natural terrain with sand, water and stone. The latest addition to the Idaho golf scene, Falcon Crest Golf Club opened for play April 2001. Owner/architect Hans Borbonus, designed Falcon Crest with raised tees, flat tree-lined fairways, and big undulating greens that play fast – about 9.5 on the stimpmeter. The course lies in the heart of the Boise valley, and golfers will be treated to beautiful views of the surrounding mountains from throughout the course. There are 11 lakes that come into play on at least 11 holes. Falcon Crest ranks in the Top 5 in Idaho on Golfweek's 2007 Best Courses You Can Play ratings.
