Monday, March 4, 2019: Visit to Fallbrook:



Grand Tradition Estate & Gardens 220 Grand Tradition Way, Fallbrook, CA 92028

Although Grand Tradition Estate & Gardens is primarily a venue for weddings, the gardens are open to the public. It is a 30-acre property established in 1984 by the McDougal family containing 18 acres of thematic gardens, 7 waterfalls and a heart-shaped lake. Senior rate to tour the gardens is \$5.

Fallbrook Art Center, 103 S. Main Ave., Fallbrook, CA 92028: The arts center presents a wide variety of rotating exhibitions featuring works by internationally and regionally recognized artists. Exhibitions include "10th Annual World of Watercolor & Beyond" and "One Medium – Three Approaches". Admission is \$6.

Myrtle Creek Botanical Gardens & Nursery, 2940 Reche Road, Fallbrook, CA 92028: Under the shade of the live oaks, wander the splendid displays of flowers, plants, gardens, and varieties of blooming color, shrubbery, and trees. Tour the Wild Bird Sanctuary, Butterfly Gardens and historic Fallbrook Barn, home to a few lucky farm animals who still call this barn home.

Tuesday, March 5, 2019: Temecula Valley Museum, 28314 Mercedes Street, Temecula, CA 92590 and Old Town Temecula

Take a step back in time and experience the rich history of the Temecula Valley. Displays depict key stories, including the Luiseno Indians, Mission San Luis Rey period, establishment of the ranchos and transportation influences including the stagecoach and railroads. Erle Stanley Gardner (Perry Mason Author) lived in Temecula from 1937 until 1970. The exhibit features a reproduction of his Temecula office, a video and select memorabilia.

Old Town Temecula: A historic 12-block downtown district is home to Temecula Valley's history and more. Old Town combines the region's storied past and its exciting up-and-coming future. Take a step back in time as you walk the wooden boardwalks past rustic western-era buildings, antique shops, and specialty boutiques featuring Temeculamade artisan goods. Over the last few years winery tasting rooms and wine tasting bars have opened in Old Town Temecula to bring a taste of wine country to historic Old Town.

Thursday, March 7, 2019: Oceanside Whale and Dolphin Watching Adventures: 256 Harbor Drive S. Oceanside, CA 92054



During Nov-April, it is common to see gray whales, minke whales, humpback, fin whales and all 4 species of dolphin. The trip lasts 2 hours and the cost is \$34 for seniors – might be less if we can find a special deal. The trips are narrated by expert Captains and marine naturalists. The vessel has covered and uncovered areas so may need sunscreen.
