HEADQUARTERS

Our headquarters will be the Northern Quest Resort & Casino, 100 N. Hayford Road, Airway Heights, WA 99001. Phone 1-877-871-6772. We have been given a daily rate of \$129. In order to obtain this rate you must make your reservation prior to May 24th 2019, and ask for the Pacific Senior Golf Association Rate. There is no charge for parking or wi-fi. A limited number of rooms are available on Friday & Saturday June 21-22 (\$129/night) and Friday & Saturday June 28 - 29 (\$169/night). THINGS TO DO IN EASTERN WASHINGTON

If you wish to play more golf while in the area, Coeur d'Alene Resort with its famous floating island green is a must. This is 45 miles east from Northern Quest, reservations are recommended. Closer by is the Indian Canyon golf course, this is one I would have selected for our tournament but it has/is undergoing major renovations and the course could not guarantee availability. I also really enjoyed the Links course in Post Falls, a true links style golf course with no trees, 36 miles from Northern Quest. One of the gems of the area is Circling Raven GC, about 40 miles SouthEast from Northern Quest.

81 miles to the west is the Grand Coulee Dam, a concrete gravity dam on the Columbia River in the U.S. state of Washington, built to produce hydroelectric power and provide irrigation water. It is the largest power station in the United States by nameplate-capacity at 6,809 MW.

52 miles to the Northwest is Fort Spokane, The National Park Service operates Fort Spokane as a visitor center and museum. During the summer, the guardhouse is open as the visitor center and museum. The grounds are open year-round with accessible walking trails. Step back in history with a tour of the museum exhibits and grounds.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the executive secretary on June 15th. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the executive secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted in the hotel within two hours of the day's golf being completed, and on our web-site www.psqa.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps. **WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play**. Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. We will be repeating the mixed team play event on Wednesday due to the success at Temecula. Selecting team members will be performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps. Men and Women handicap equalization will be based on USGA guidelines. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.
