HEADQUARTERS

Our headquarters will be the Lake Natoma Inn, 702 Gold Lake Drive, Folsom, CA 95630 Phone # (916) 351-1500. We have been given a daily rate of \$135. **In order to obtain this rate you must make your reservation prior to September 24th 2019, and ask for the PSGA Rate.** This rate includes a hot buffet breakfast, and complimentary parking and wi-fi. This rate is available for three days before and three days after the tournament.

THINGS TO DO IN THE CALIFORNIA GOLD COUNTRY

Folsom's name is recognizable throughout the world in part due to the prison that Johnny Cash made famous – Folsom State Prison. In 2014, the City opened the Johnny Cash Trail and Bike/Pedestrian bridge overcrossing, which highlights the legacy of the musician and the unique architecture of the prison.

22 miles to the East is Marshall Gold Discovery State Historical Park which marks the discovery of gold by James W. Marshall at Sutter's Mill in 1848, sparking the California Gold Rush. Continuing East and 25 miles from the hotel is Placerville, affectionately called "Old Hangtown" for its Wild West-style of justice. Well-preserved Main Street boasts the town's oldest building, the rustic stone Fountain & Tallman Soda Works.

25 Miles to the west is Old Sacramento with many places of interest, including the California Automobile Museum, California State Railroad Museum, William Land Park and Zoo and Underground Tours.

There are many wineries in the area. I am sure the hotel will have a wine tour guide pamphlet.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

If you wish to play more golf while in the area, I would recommend Apple Mountain GC, a demanding fun course with elevation changes and lots of trees. If you want a drive down historic highway 49 and play golf, I can recommend La Contenta, Greenhorn Creek and Saddle Creek.

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the executive secretary on October 1st. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the executive secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted in the hotel within two hours of the day's golf being completed, and on our web-site www.psga.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps. **WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play.** Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. We will be repeating the mixed team play event on Wednesday due to the success at Temecula and Spokane. Selecting team members will be performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps. Men and Women handicap equalization will be based on USGA guidelines. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.
