THINGS TO DO IN COACHELLA VALLEY

We should be in Coachella Valley just as the desert starts to put on its annual display of colors. Check web-sites of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park and Thousand Palms for reports on the blooms as the time varies from year to year. A trip on the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway provides views of the whole valley, but check the weather at the top of the tramway, snow is a distinct possibility.

Down in the valley there are many interesting places to visit including the Living Desert with its assortment of wildlife, flowers and model railway. A trip to the Palm Springs Air Museum can easily fill up a whole afternoon. Named by CNN Travel as one of the world's top fourteen aviation museums, it features over fifty static and flyable planes on display within four hangars and the tarmac. Each hangar has a theme and includes related exhibits along the walls. Closer to the hotel is the Shields Date Farm where you can learn about the Sex Life of a Date.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the Executive Secretary on February 15th. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the executive secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted in the hotel within two hours of the day's golf being completed, and on our web-site www.psga.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps. **WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play**. Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. This is a mixed event, selecting team members performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps, based on the USGA guidelines for different tees used by men and women. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.
