Our headquarters will be the Gold Dust West, 2171 E. William St, Carson City, NV 89701 To make a reservation call Sharon Human Mon – Fri 9:am to 4 pm at 775-671-3458. Leave a message if she is not available. The five night room rates are as follows-Arrival Sunday, July 19 and Departure Friday, July 24, King or Double Queen Deluxe Is \$477 for single or double occupancy. King or Double Queen Jr Suites are also available at the rate \$532 for single or double occupancy. If you plan on arriving on Saturday, July 18, King or Double Queen will be an additional \$99.90 and King or Double Queen Jr Suites will be an additional \$111.00. **In order to obtain these rates you must make your reservation prior to July 1st 2020, and ask for the PSGA Rate.**

Your credit card will be charged at the time your reservation is made. This charge is for the full amount but is fully refundable. This rate includes breakfast, complimentary parking and wi-fi and is inclusive of all taxes. Sharon is very good to work with and will work with you on rates if you require other days or room types.

THINGS TO DO FROM CARSON CITY

I should begin this section with a warning. At the time of writing I am unsure on what facilities are open. I am advising destinations from past experiences of the area. The obvious attraction is Lake Tahoe, under 30 minutes from Carson City, just follow the freeway from the hotel. Again at the time of writing South Lake Tahoe (California) is advising tourists to stay away, they were giving out \$1000 files but have ceased that. The Nevada side of the lake is open as are the Casinos. In Carson City I can recommend the Nevada State Museum and Mint, the Nevada State Capitol building and the Nevada State Railway Museum. A short drive away I can recommend the town of Genoa and of course Virginia City is a must If you have not been there before.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the Executive Secretary on July 1. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the Executive Secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted on the outside of the business center in the hotel within two hours of the day's golf being completed, and on our web-site www.psga.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps. **WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play.** Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. This is a mixed event, selecting team members performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps, based on the USGA guidelines for different tees used by men and women. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.

Issues regarding Covid-19

I have been talking to the hotel and golf courses and I have got the feeling that 60% of the people in Carson City are not wearing masks. The general reasoning for this is that Northern Nevada has a very low infection rate, and the Governor has not mandated the wearing of masks.

Changes to standard PSGA tournament.

There will be no organized SS&G activities, as we don't know what will be open and the sharing of cars is discouraged.

No Sunday Registration

- 1) Tournament packages (details, badges, meal tickets) will be given out when you register at the hotel. If you are not staying at the hotel please contact me and we can make alternate arrangements.
- 2) No on-site entry into any competition (team play, skins). Make sure you complete the entry form for all competitions you wish to enter.
- 3) No tee prizes (golf balls)

Banquets

- 1) Open Seating (Tables of 4)
- 2) Bar (There will be marks on the floor specifying the social distancing while queuing for drinks. Please wear a mask whenever possible)
- 3) There will be no distribution of prizes or skins on Thursday
Checks will be mailed out the following week, one check per household.
No trophies (trophy labels will be sent to winners)

Golf

- 1) Max shotgun is currently 50, but all the courses have said they would work with me if we got to 60.
- 2) All the courses have restrictors that prevent the ball from falling to the bottom of the cup, but allow the ball to be holed.
- 3) There will be no rakes in sand traps. Should your ball finish in an area of the sand trap that is in need of raking you may lift the ball, and place it anywhere in the trap no nearer the hole, no penalty.
- 4) One person per cart
- 5) Some courses may send you out to your holes early to prevent groups forming. If instructed to do so, please wait for the allotted start time before hitting your first shot.

Scoring

- 1) Golfers will hand in their cards to me at the course and will wait somewhere in the scoring room, I will enter their scores (no reading them out) and ask for clarification if needed before allowing golfers to leave the room.
- 2) Scores AND SKINS will be posted on the internet. And will also be posted outside the business center at the hotel. Please observe social distancing when admiring your scores
