HEADQUARTERS

Our headquarters will be Corque Hotel, 400 Alisal Road, Solvang, CA 93464, phone (805) 688-8000. We have been given a daily rate of \$158 plus taxes. **In order to obtain this rate you must make your reservation by September 5, 2024 by calling 1-800-248-6274 and asking for the Pacific Senior Golf Association Rate.** Please reserve your room as soon as you can as the number of rooms in our block is limited. A limited number of rooms are available on the Saturday before the tournament at a rate of \$338++.

We encourage our membership to bring guests to our tournaments. Guests participate in all the activities and are eligible for all prizes. They must have an established USGA handicap and meet our age requirements (over 50). The Members entry fees will apply. Applications from guests will be accepted immediately.

BREAKFAST:

The golf courses do not provide breakfast prior to our tee-times. Please note that the golf courses are a 45 minute drive away, plan breakfast accordingly. For the SS&Gers, breakfast is available in the Craft House, adjacent to the hotel, from 9:00am but is closed on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

BANQUETS:

The Sunday Welcoming Banquet is dress casual, and the Thursday Awards Banquet is evening casual. A corkage fee of \$20 is required for members wishing to bring their own wine to the banquets. Tickets available from Alan Hargreaves. There will be a cash bar available from 6:00pm on both banquet nights.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the Executive Secretary on September 15th. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the Executive Secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted in the TBD within two hours of the day's golf being completed and posted on our web-site www.psga.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Wednesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps.

TUESDAY will be optional Team Play. Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. This is a mixed event, selecting team members performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps, based on the USGA guidelines for different tees used by men and women. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.

We now allow men to have a choice of tees, the Normal tees and a Forward tee. Handicaps will be adjusted to the tee used, but please note that these cannot be changed after the entry deadline date on the entry form. Ladies, I apologize, there is usually not a more forward tee for you to move to.
