### **Monday, October 7, 2024: Motorized Trolley Tour, 1618 Copenhagen Dr., Solvang, CA 93463**



All aboard for a tour of downtown Solvang to view the architecture and attractions of the town on a replica of a 1800's Danish streetcar. Tour guides tell the history of Solvang, explain the origin and significance of many sights and buildings, and share folk tales and culture notes from Denmark. They also provide an insight on activities in town and give general information about the area. Cost for seniors is \$16 (65+)

### **Olive and Lavender Farm, 2450 Alamo Pintado Road, Los Olivos, CA 93441**

This farm is a beautiful and charming property boasting stunning, imported olive trees and a variety of lavender along the famous Stagecoach stop at Lansing's Crossing. The site was once a blacksmith shop for the stagecoaches and has a rich history. Enjoy a tasting of olive oils or vinegars that interest you together with Bob's Well Bread for dipping on the patio or in the air-conditioned tasting room.

The museum holds an impressive collection of amber antiques and artifacts. A visit to Copenhagen House is a must to see some of the best jewelry, fashion and design products from contemporary Denmark.

**Old Mission Santa Ines, 1760 Mission Drive, Solvang, CA 93463**

This Mission was the nineteenth of the 21 missions built in California from 1769 to 1836 by Spanish Franciscan priests led by Father Junipero Serra. The Mission was founded on September 17, 1804 by Father Estevan Tapis. It was the first European settlement in the Santa Ynez Valley.
