HEADQUARTERS

Our headquarters will be Embassy Suites Santa Ana Orange County Airport North, 1325 East Dyer Road, Santa Ana, California, 92705, USA. Phone (714) 241-3800. We have been given a daily rate of \$159 plus taxes and fees for a king room, and \$169 plus taxes and fees for a double queen room. This rate includes a complimentary cooked to order breakfast, complimentary parking, and a manager's reception every night from 5:30pm to 7:00pm 2 free drinks limit. **In order to obtain this rate you must make your reservation by February 28, 2025 by calling Elsa Yim at 714-241-3334, and asking for the Pacific Senior Golf Association Rate. You can also make your room reservation directly from our web-site www.psga.net. A free shuttle is available from John Wayne Airport to the hotel.**

Please reserve your room as soon as you can as the number of rooms in our block is limited. A limited number of rooms are available on the Friday and Saturday before the tournament.

GOLFERS INFORMATION

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the Executive Secretary on March 15th 2025. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the Executive Secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted in the TBD within two hours of the day's golf being completed and posted on our web-site www.psga.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps.

WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play. Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. This is a mixed event, selecting team members performed by computer after equalizing team handicaps and individual handicaps, based on the USGA guidelines for different tees used by men and women. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

Please adhere to the dress code of the courses we are playing. This typically implies collared shirts and no denim.

We now allow men to have a choice of tees, the Normal tees and a Forward tee. Handicaps will be adjusted to the tee used, but please note that these cannot be changed after the entry deadline date on the entry form. Ladies, I apologize, there is usually not a more forward tee for you to move to.
