Monday, October 27, 2025: Old Town Albuquerque, La Hacienda Parking Lot, Old Town Road Northwest & San Pasquale Ave NW.



Old Town Albuquerque is the vibrant cultural center of Albuquerque and the southwest. It is a popular tourist destination with a large number of restaurants, shops, and galleries. At the center is the Old Town Plaza surrounded by approximately ten blocks of one- and two-story buildings. Old Town Plaza dates to the original founding of the city in early 1700s and remains the center of Old Town.

Turquoise Museum, 400 2nd St SW, Albuquerque, NM 87102

Visiting the Turquoise Museum is fun for all ages. The museum is housed in a castle-like building, and includes an introductory movie, a self-guided tour of the exhibits, and interactive stations.

Tuesday, October 28, 2025: Petroglyph National Monument, Information Center, 9131 Western Trail, Albuquerque, NM 87120 (Piedras Marcadas Canyon, 9421 Jill Patricia St. NW Albuquerque, NM 87114)

The landscape that surrounds the petroglyphs forms a spiritual world with profound value for indigenous communities. Petroglyphs are fragile, irreplaceable cultural resources important in our collective human history. The petroglyph viewing trail at Piedras Marcadas Canyon has approximately 400 images and the trail is classified as an easy, level, sandy trail.

Thursday, October 30, 2025: Sandia Peak Tramway, 30 Tramway Rd NE, Albuquerque, NM 87122



The tramway is the longest aerial tram ride in North America. It takes visitors 2.7 miles or 10,378 feet up the Sandia Mountains. Breathe in the fresh mountain air and enjoy breathtaking views of over 11,000 square miles of New Mexico. Fall is a great time to visit to see the changing leaves on the mountainside. It is much colder on the mountain top than in the city so bring layers and a jacket. The Ten 3 restaurant offers delicious cuisine.

Alternative for Thursday: ABQ Trolley Co. 204 San Felipe St NW, Albuquerque, NM 87104

The open-air Trolley departs from the Historic Old Town Plaza and is a narrated adventure through the heart of Albuquerque. The tour lasts approximately 100 minutes and explores the city's vibrant culture, iconic landmarks and hidden gems.
