HEADQUARTERS

Our headquarters hotel will be the Westward Look Wyndham Grand Resort & Spa, 245 East Ina Rd, Tucson, AZ 85704. The Reservation number is 1-520-917-2970, available Monday – Friday 8:00am – 5:00pm MST and ask for the **Pacific Senior Golf Association Group Rate**. A link from our web-site will also be available to make your room reservation. To clarify the time differences between the West Coast and Arizona, currently there is a one hour time difference, but when daylight saving time starts on March 11, the week before our tournament, there will be no time difference until November.

We have been offered a special rate of \$149. There will also be a \$1,50 per day housekeeping gratuity and a resort fee which has been reduced to \$5.00 per day. The rate includes a \$10 voucher per room per day to be used in the GOLD restaurant for breakfast or dinner. The rate also includes complimentary self-parking and complimentary wifi. In order to obtain this rate you must make your reservation prior to February 25th, 2018 This rate is also available 3 days prior/post the tournament based on availability.

Golf Overview

Handicaps will be downloaded from the internet by the executive secretary on March 1st. A list of these handicaps will be posted on the internet at www.psga.net. If there is a discrepancy with the index, please contact the executive secretary immediately.

Scores will be posted inside the Business Centre within two hours of the day's golf being completed, and on our web-site www.psqa.net shortly afterwards.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be Medal Play, full handicap and flighted by handicaps. **WEDNESDAY will be optional Team Play**. Team Play format is teams of 4 golfers, using two better balls for scoring. If your group has less than 4 players, the team will be filled with a blind draw.

El Conquistador, Conquistador Course

The Conquistador Course at El Conquistador Golf & Tennis is a recently renovated Greg Nash and Jeff Hardin design offering state-of-the-art agronomic conditions. The Conquistador Course is located in a lush, park-like setting adjacent to the clubhouse by the driving range. Fringed with natural mesquite and palo verde trees, this fabulous 18 hole course is intertwined with vibrant desert flora and offers four sets of tee boxes suitable for golfers of all abilities. Wide, open fairways and long holes provide the challenge of negotiating desert vegetation.

Omni Tuscon National, Catalina Course

The Catalina Golf Course is the host to over 30 PGA Tour events (Chrysler Classic of Tucson), the annual host of the University of Arizona Invitational, and the 2006 host of the NCAA Regionals.

The course has been selected as one of Golf Digest's "75 Best Golf Resorts in North America." It is parkland style with 8 sparkling lakes and 80 bunkers. The 18th hole considered to be one of the finest and most challenging finishing holes on the PGA Tour.

Designed by Robert Van Hagge and Bruce Devlin, the fairways feature Tifway 419 pollen-free Bermuda and the greens feature Champion Bermuda.

Omni Tucson National, Sonoran Course

Designed by Tom Lehman, this desert style course with 2 lakes and 69 strategically placed bunkers and has been open since December 2005. This Tom Lehman designed course offers a combination of native desert vegetation with strategic fairway bunkering. Players can approach each hole in a variety of ways, keeping the course challenging and unique with each new round. The fairways feature Tifway 419 pollen-free Bermuda and the greens feature Mini Verde Bermuda.

Quarry Pines GC (Team Play)

In 2000, following a decision to abandon the sand and gravel quarry adjacent to the original golf course, the Town of Marana and the quarry/golf course owner agreed on a plan that would reclaim the quarry. By relocating 10 golf holes into the old quarry and reconfiguring 8 of the existing holes one of Tucson's most popular golf courses was transformed. Today the unique desert landscape is highlighted by dramatic elevation changes and the addition of thousands of trees.

Play for Fun.

This new option is for members who wish to just play golf and not strictly follow the rules of golf. They will be paired in the same foursome(s), and may play from any tee, pick-up whenever they want, and of course use gimme's. This group will not be eligible for any prizes or skins. It is estimated that the cost of the golf will be \$20 less than the cost of full participation. You may create your own foursome, men and women can be paired together. The golfer also does not need an official handicap. As always we ask that you keep up with the group in front.

Forward Tees for men.

The second option will be to allow the men to play from the forward tees. Again this group will be paired together and play as their own flight. There will be flight prizes, but they will not be eligible for overall prizes, skins, KP prizes or hole in one Prize. We will review participation in this flight prior to the tournament, and discuss with those concerned whether the numbers justify this separate flight. Ladies usually play from the most forward tees, therefore I do not believe this could be an option for them.
